Description

Shawn Wildermuth is a Microsoft MVP, author, and speaker. He has spent a year on the road meeting developers around the world. This free, community event will be dedicated to software developers in each of these cities.

The event will consist of two parts:

- A live recording of Shawn's well-regarded podcast (Hello World Podcast – <http://hwpod.com>) with a local developer as the guest.
- A technical talk entitled: "Building Web Apps with ASP.NET 5"

We will be providing food and beverages as well as giveaways at the end of the evening's festivities. Since this is a one-time only event, we expect to have developers across skill level show up to see Shawn.

Attendance

We expect approximately 1,600 developers over the twenty-three dates. We expect developers across the spectrum of software including:

- Front-End Developers
- Enterprise Developers
- Architects
- Database Developers
- Web Developers

Shawn speaks at conferences across the world and this is many developers' only chance to see him in their town. We started registrations in November and expect many of the venues to sell out well before the events are held.

How much does it cost?

Giveaway Items
